MEDITATION AWAKENS AWARENESS

Meditation is the first step to take on the inner journey. In meditation we are not thinking about God or talking to God. We are being with God. Contemplative awareness is inbuilt; it is not taught or downloaded into us, it is awakened.

How to Meditate

*Sit down. Sit still with your back straight.

Close your eyes.

*Silently recite a single word mantra. Breathe normally and give your full attention to the word as you say it, silently, gently, faithfully and above all simply. Stay with the same word during the whole meditation from day to day. Let go of all thoughts, images and other words. Don't fight your distractions but let them go by saying our word faithfully, gently and attentively and returning to it immediately that you realise you have stopped saying it or when your attention is wandering.

ANNUAL ST JOSEPH'S CAMINO SALVADO PILGRIMAGE 2020

23 Aug to 30 Aug

The annual St Joseph's Camino Savado Pilgrimage walks from Subiaco to New Norcia are scheduled for **Sunday 23 August to Sunday 30 August** and **Sunday 6 September to Sunday 13 September**. The Camino Salvado is a pilgrimage conducted under the auspices of St Joseph's Church, Subiaco Parish, following the tradition of the famous Spanish Camino de Santiago from Subiaco to the unique monastery town of New Norcia. We walk in the spirit of Dom Rosendo Salvado Rotea OSB, a pioneering monk from Santiago in Spain who established the monastery in New Norcia.

We follow his inspirational journey of 1846 to connect with country and community. The pilgrimage is an opportunity to travel lightly, to walk free of the daily routines, to meet people, to make friends, to enjoy and celebrate God's creation. An opportunity too, in the travelling, the conversations and the silences to reflect on the journey of our lives. The pilgrimage attracts a variety of people, Christians and non-Christians of all ages, who participate in this unique Australian Camino.
