MEDITATION AWAKENS AWARENESS

Meditation is the first step to take on the inner journey. In meditation we are not thinking about God or talking to God. We are being with God. Contemplative awareness is inbuilt; it is not taught or downloaded into us, it is awakened.

How to Meditate

Sit still with your back straight. Close your eyes. Silently recite a single word mantra. Breathe normally. Give full attention to the word as you say it, silently, gently, faithfully and simply. Stay with the same word during the whole meditation from day to day. Let go of all thoughts, images and other words. Don't fight your distractions. Let them go by saying our word faithfully, gently and attentively and returning to it immediately that you have stopped saying it or your attention wanders
