Let us resolve to include some time to pray, to reflect on the Gospel stories of Jesus' birth, and to seek reconciliation with God and others, in our Christmas preparations.*

## **YOUR DETAILS REQUIRED WHEN ATTENDING MASS - COVID -19 CONTACT REGISTER AT HOLY ROSARY, CARMEL**

It is mandatory from 5 December for churches, chapels and Mass centres to keep Contact Registers.

Any person aged 16 years and over who attends, including patrons, staff, volunteers and contractors must register their contact details. The details required include:

- full name;
- contact number;
- date, and
- arrival time at the venue.

Churches must keep the Contact Register for 28 days. The WA government accepts information either manually recorded or entered electronically onto a digital device or via the **SafeWA App**.

**When attending Holy Rosary or Carmel, please ensure you have completed your details on the Contact Register before entering.**

## **SOCIAL DISTANCING**

Churches and Chapels are now Exempt from the 2 sqm rule however please continue be mindful of social distancing. Also, with the new 60% capacity allowance for each venue means the new limits are as follows:

Church: 210 persons  
Carmel: 72 persons  
Main Hall: 60 persons
