## REFLECTION

'CALLED BY NAME.

*It can be hard to believe that God knows each of us by name. Sometimes we need a wise guide like the old priest Eli or John the Baptist, to help us recognise the voice of God in our life. Let us try to hear God's personal call to us in this Mass and in the events of this day, a call which says in a different way, 'come and dwell with me, share my life'.*

### **I Believe - Creed**
