## SUNDAY OF THE WORD OF GOD

### First Sunday in February

Towards the end of 2019, Pope Francis instituted a Sunday of the Word of God.

This was set for the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time because it is close to the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity in the northern hemisphere. But the timing is impractical for Australia with the final weeks of summer holidays, return to school and Australia Day. The Australian bishops decided to keep it close to Pope Francis' day and made it the first Sunday in February.

The Sunday of the Word of God is intended to help people to grow in religious and intimate familiarity with the sacred Scriptures and devotion to the celebration, study and dissemination of the Word of God.

### "THE TIME HAS COME"

*These are the first recorded  
words of Jesus in Mark's Gospel.  
In a variety of contexts we have  
probably used them ourselves  
when we felt that an important  
decision could be delayed no  
longer. At some point in our life,  
perhaps even today, the decision  
in question will be whether to  
follow Jesus wholeheartedly or  
in a superficial way.*

I confess to almighty God and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have greatly sinned, in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do,  
through my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault; therefore I ask blessed Mary ever-Virgin, all the Angels and Saints, and you, my brothers and sisters, to pray for me to the Lord our God.

## **Gloria**

Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will.  
We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory, Lord God, heavenly King, O God, almighty Father.  
Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us; you take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer; you are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us.  
For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. Amen.

## **I Believe – Creed**

I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made.

For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven, and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets.

I believe in one, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.
