## TOWARDS MISSIONARY DISCIPLESHIP: POPE FRANCIS AND EVANGELII GAUDIUM 20 Mar to 27 Mar

Saturdays, 10am to 11am, (four sessions) online. Pope Francis' Apostolic Exhortation, Evangelii Gaudium, encourages every Christian to engage with vigour in the mission of spreading the joy of the Gospel. For this to happen, however, one must first have an encounter with Jesus Christ. Drawing on his predecessor Pope Benedict XVI, Francis stresses that being a Christian "is not the result of an ethical choice or a lofty idea, but the encounter with an event, a person, which gives life a new horizon and a decisive direction" (#7). This course will unpack the profound message of Evangelii Gaudium and focus on its implications for evangelisation and Catholic Education in the 21st century.

### REFLECTION

#### 'THE HOUR HAS COME'.

*Jesus was greatly troubled as the hour of his suffering and death approached.*

*He was tempted to ask the Father to save him from this hour. But he knew that his death would be a source of new life for all. Today's liturgy invites us to share in Jesus' self-sacrificing love.*

*For ourselves, as for Jesus, the grain of wheat must die in order to produce a rich harvest.*

## **Penitential Act**

I confess to almighty God and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have greatly sinned, in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do, through my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault; therefore I ask blessed Mary ever-Virgin, all the Angels and Saints, and you, my brothers and sisters, to pray for me to the Lord our God.

## **I Believe – Creed**

I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made.

For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven, and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary and became man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right

hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets.

I believe in one, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

### **PLENARY COUNCIL 2021 – DISCOVERING A CHRIST-CENTRED CHURCH**
