Ezekiel 2:2-5 2 Corinthians 12:7-10 Mark 6:1-6

Penitential Act

I confess to almighty God and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have greatly sinned, in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do, through my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault; therefore I ask blessed Mary ever-Virgin, all the Angels and Saints, and you, my brothers and sisters, to pray for me to the Lord our God.

ARCHBISHOP'S PASTORAL LETTER – VOLUNTARY ASSISTED DYING (VAD)

On Thursday, 1 July 2021, legislation passed by the Western Australian State Parliament in relation to 'Voluntary Assisted Dying' (VAD) will be enacted. Put simply this legislation will permit a person, under certain specified conditions, to access medication which is designed to cause that person's death. The legislation will also permit other people, again under certain specified conditions, to provide assistance to those who without such assistance would be unable to administer the medication to themselves. In this regard Archbishop Timothy Costelloe has issued a Pastoral Letter which is available on the Archdiocesan.
